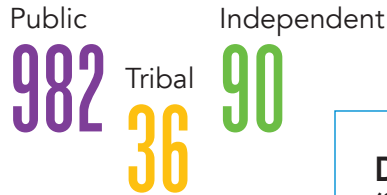

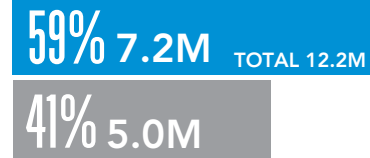
NUMBER & TYPE OF COLLEGES (2017)¹

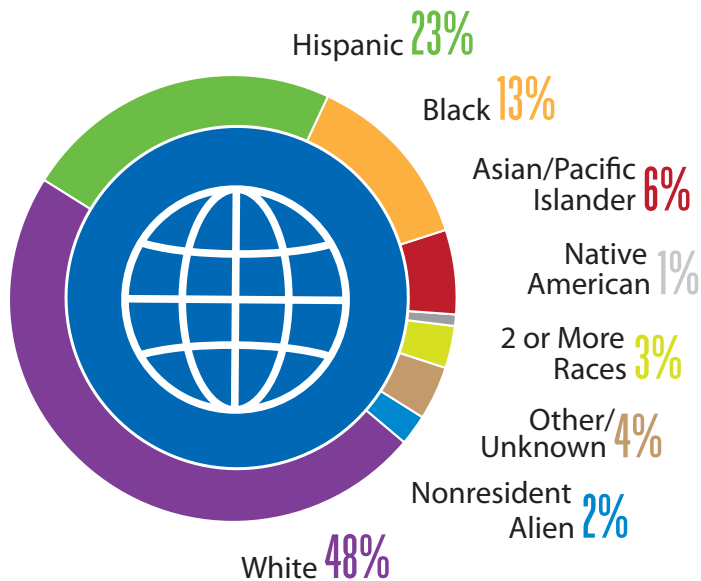

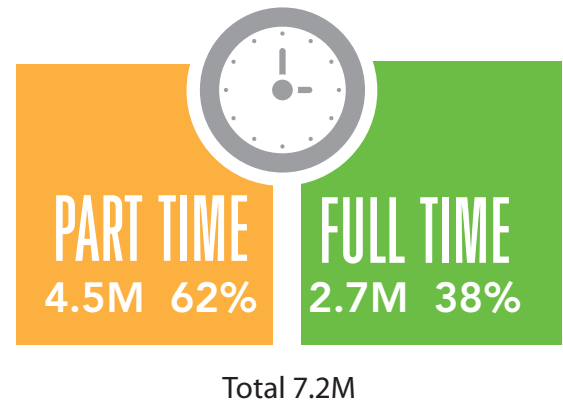
DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES AWARDED (2014-2015)⁷



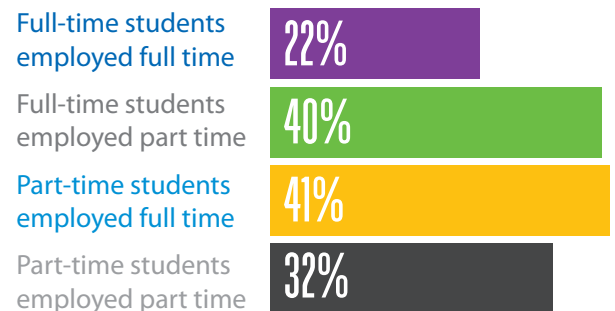
DEMOGRAPHICS OF STUDENTS ENROLLED FOR CREDIT²



CREDIT BY ATTENDANCE²



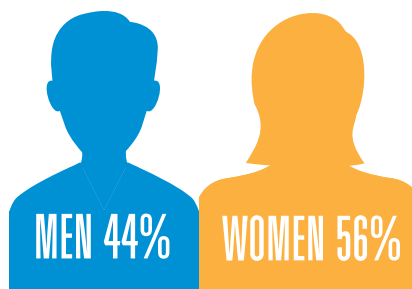
EMPLOYMENT STATUS (2011-2012)⁴



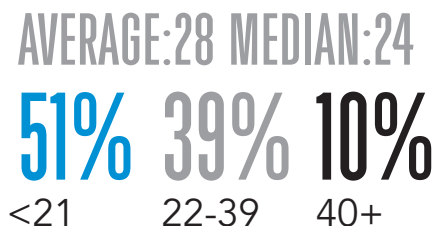

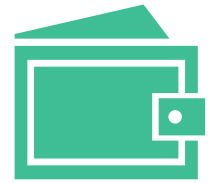
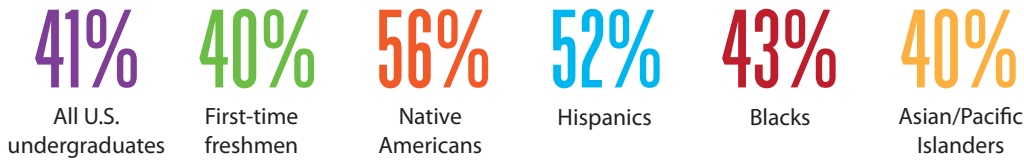

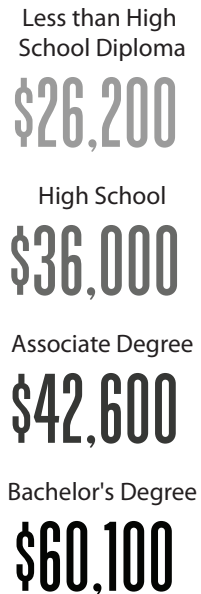

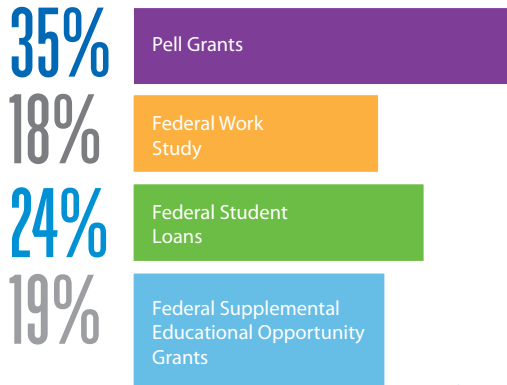
REPRESENTATION OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENTS AMONG UNDERGRADUATES (FALL 2015)²



MEDIAN EARNING OF FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES BY EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT¹⁰



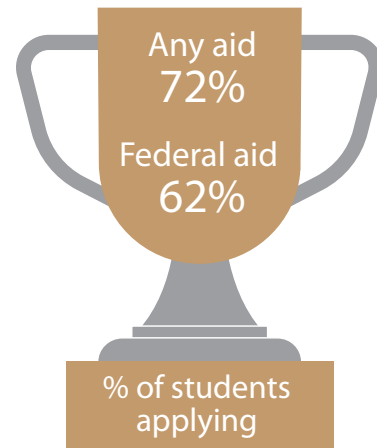
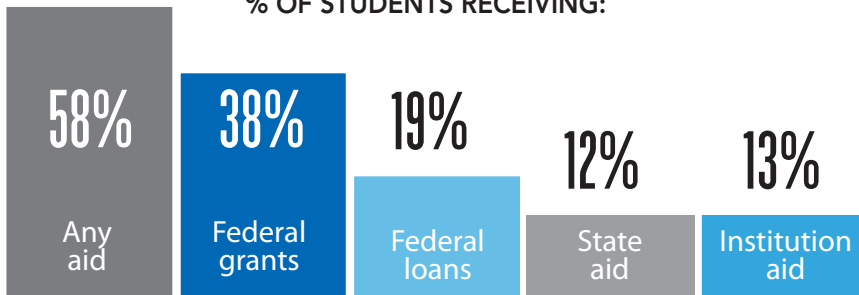
% OF FEDERAL AID RECEIVED BY COMMUNITY COLLEGE (2014-2015)⁵



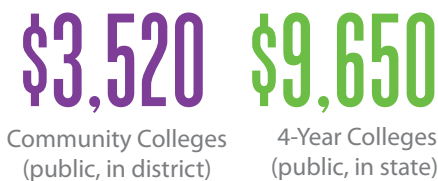
