
NSF ATE Program Background



- Congressionally mandated program, NSF provides grants to improve and expand programs that prepare skilled technicians to work in high-tech fields
- Promotes the improvement in the education of STEM technicians at the undergraduate and secondary school level
- Emphasizes partnerships among two-year colleges, secondary schools, four-year colleges and universities, business, industry and government
- Supports curriculum development; professional development of college faculty and secondary school teachers; career pathways to two-year colleges from secondary schools and from two-year colleges to four-year institutions; and other activities.



- AACC is seeking 15 community college teams, consisting of a STEM faculty member & an administrator, from:
 - MSI's
 - Rural serving institutions
 - Colleges new to NSF ATE



Summit Eligibility & How to Apply

- College teams are asked to:
 - Demonstrate a strong interest in learning more about NSF and ATE
 - Engage in Summit and ATE Conference
 - Commit to implementing STEM resources and promising strategies
 - Consider pursuing further STEM mentoring & NSF funding opportunities
 - Participate in pre- and post-event evaluation surveys and follow-up



Summit Eligibility & How to Apply

- College teams are asked to apply online and submit:
 - Name of institution
 - Institutional designation as MSI, rural, and/or new to ATE
 - Contact info for faculty member & administrator team
 - College STEM program area
 - Three main challenges the college is facing in STEM program development, improvement or implementation
 - Promising strategies and resources that the college would like to assist them in addressing their STEM challenges
 - Activities & outcomes the college hopes to undertake as result of participating
 - Bios for team members
 - Statements of interest from each team member
 - Certifications and signatures
