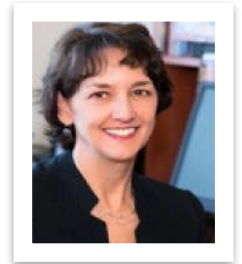


What is the HSI ATE Hub?

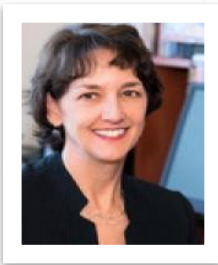
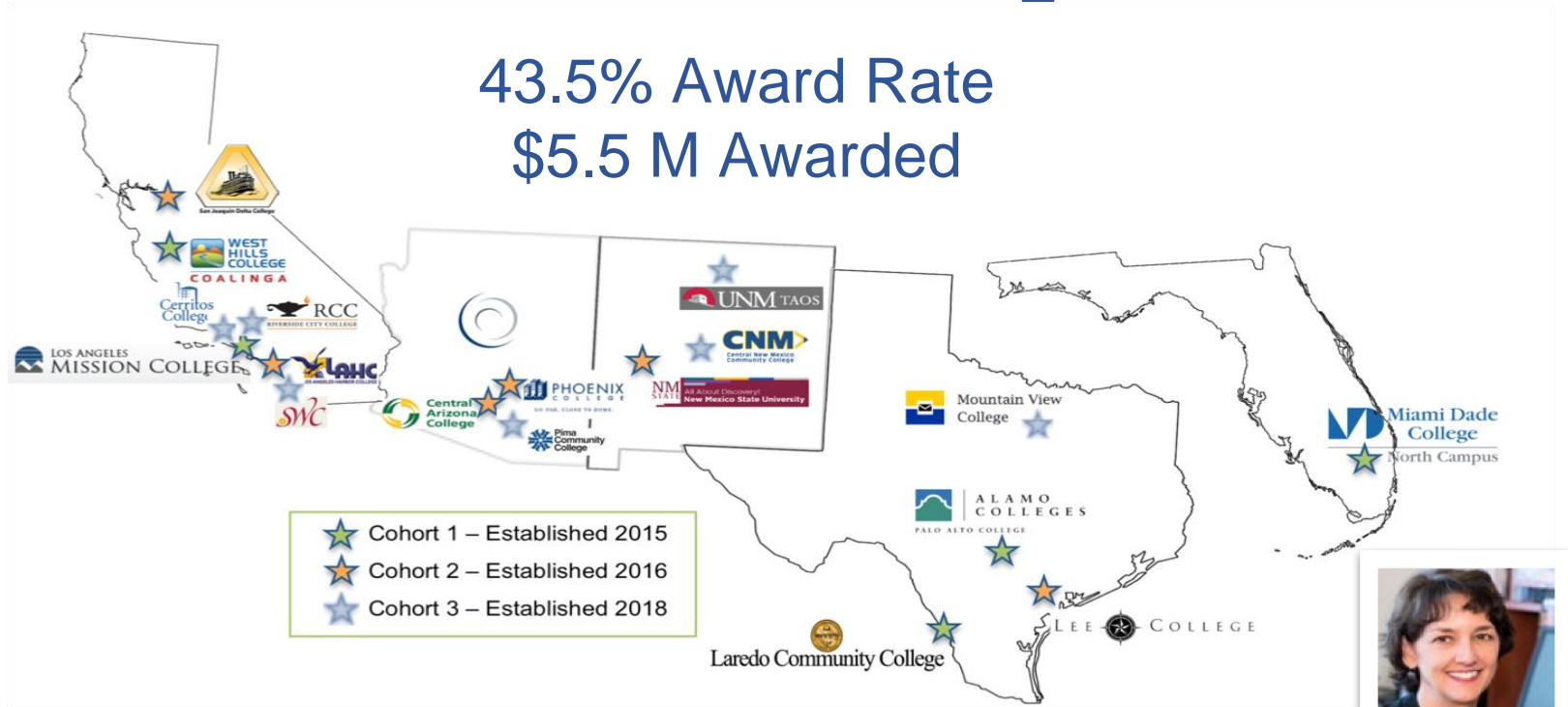

Question 3: *What resources/solutions would better help you support your students and to what extent do you have access to these types of resources/solutions in your community?*

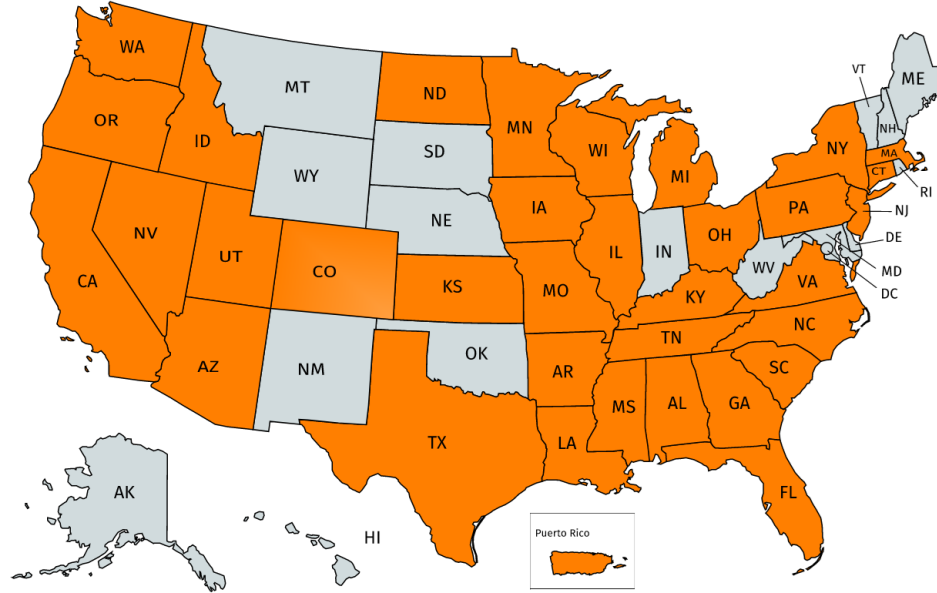
