




Graduation Rate by Student Population











Class of 2018: Highest Graduation Rate in WCSD History




2017-2018 Enrollment

WCSD CTE 2017-2018 Enrollment



- 21% of TMCC students take a class in the Tech Sciences Division
- Spring 2018 unduplicated headcount, Division of Tech Science: 2,190

Job Outlook

- 52,000 new jobs will be added in five Northern Nevada counties by 2020.
- 80% of the positions will require skills that can be obtained through community college certificates and associate degrees.












Explosive Job Growth Projected












MIDDLE-SKILL JOBS STATE BY STATE NEVADA

Nevada's Forgotten Middle

Middle-skill jobs, which require education beyond high school but not a four-year degree, make up the largest part of America's and Nevada's labor market. Key industries in Nevada are unable to find enough sufficiently trained workers to fill these jobs.



Demand for Middle-Skill Jobs is Strong

Fifty-one percent of all jobs in 2015 were middle-skill.





TMCC Panasonic Preferred Pathway (P3)

TMCC, Panasonic, and the Nevada Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) partnered to create an accelerated pathway.






The Panasonic Preferred Pathway (P3) program is designed as an employment credential for people with no manufacturing experience, funding available for qualified individuals completing the P3 Program.



Dual Credit Options

- **ACE Charter High School** WCSD students taking classes at the Applied Technology Center
- **TMCC High School** embedded WCSD HS at TMCC
- Jump Start HS juniors and seniors taking TMCC courses for HS and college credit
- **Other Dual Credit** any WCSD students taking TMCC courses and earning HS and College Credit with HS counselor's permission
- CTE College Credit (former Tech Prep) federally funded with Perkins; courses taught by HS teachers at the high school; articulated to earn college credit


