#### Youth Apprenticeship



- State-wide program combining in-class learning with paid work experience.
- Program started in Wisconsin in 1991
- Grant funded by the Department of Workforce Development

#### **Students:**

- work at least 450 hours in one year under the supervision of a skilled mentor
- are required to complete specific employability & occupational skills that are defined by Wisconsin industries
- receive a state Certificate of Occupational Proficiency after completing the program
- may have the opportunity to bridge into a Registered Apprenticeship program in certain career clusters
